for CHA Suggested Backpacking Hikes



[Campfire Permit](#) required for backpacking stove or campfire, acquire online, good for entire year. No other permits needed

[Red Flag Warning](#) do not make a campfire. These are short term events

Seasonal Fire Restrictions

These are generally summer/fall bans on backcountry fires, dates vary year to year.

[Bureau of Land Management](#) (Inks Creek Point, Paynes Creek Point, Yana Camp, Cache Creek Ford)

[Lassen National Forest](#) (Rocky Pool, Bigleaf Pool, Arkright Springs, Hat Creek Rim, Myrtle Flat, Jonesville Canyon, Humboldt Peak, Butt Mtn, Saucer Lake)

- 2016-2018 earliest closure started July 20, latest closure started Aug 1
- 2019 no announced closure

[Plumas National Forest](#) (Chips Creek)

- 2016-2019 earliest closure started June 30, latest closure started Aug 18

The Yolla Bolly, Thousand Lakes, and Caribou Wildernesses are generally exempt from seasonal fire restrictions.

- May be special closures due to active fires
